(2) Vocabulary

- Post Office (noun) -
 - Mail office; a government department or agency handling the transmission of mail.
 - Example: Lisa asked me to mail her letters to the nearest post office.
- Stamp (noun) -

- printed paper affixed in evidence that a tax has been paid
- Example: I saw several kinds of stamps at the post office yesterday.
- Package (noun) -
 - a wrapped or boxed thing or group of things; parcel
 - Example: For destinations overseas we send all packages by Air Mail.

(3) Conversation

Anne is at the post office. She is talking to the clerk.

Clerk: May I help you?

Anne: Yes, please. I need some stamps for this card.

Clerk: Let me weigh it for you.

That is one dollar and fifty cents.

Anne: Okay. Thank you.

Clerk: Do you need anything else?

Clerk: Let me weigh it for you.

That is three dollars and ten cents.

Anne: Here you are.

That is four dollars and sixty cents.

Clerk: Thank you. Is that all?

Anne: Yes it is. Thanks for all your help.
