At the Post Office (2)

(1) Vocabulary

- Express Mail -
 - Refers to a fast delivery service for which the customer pays a surcharge and receives a faster delivery.
 - a method or service for transporting goods or sending money or mail rapidly, but at extra cost
 - Example: I am expecting to have my package shipped within 24 hours through express mail.
- Package (noun) -
 - a wrapped or boxed thing or group of things; parcel
 - Example: For destinations overseas we send all packages by Air Mail.
- Declaration of content -
 - Enumeration, listing, saying all the items in the package or mail.
 - Example:
