Renting a Car (1)



- (1) Useful expressions
 - Fast Traffic
 - Expressway
 - Car rental
 - Hitting the road
 - Catch one's eye
 - Pay through the nose.
 - Hybrid / compact car
- (2) Vocabulary
 - Sightseeing (noun) -
 - The act of visiting places and things of interest, for pleasure, education, etc.
 - Example: He had visited London with his wife on a European sightseeing trip.





- Expressway (noun)-
 - a divided highway for through traffic, with full or partial control of access and generally with overpasses or underpasses at intersections
 - Example: Green signs used for toll expressway or highways only.
- Hit the road (idioms)-
 - To start a journey; To leave; go away.
 - o Example: It's getting late I'd better hit the road.
