## （1）Useful expressions

Catch one＇s eye
－Meaning：To attract one＇s attention
－Example：＂She was planning on renting a compact car，but a nice sports car caught her eye，and she left the parking lot with it．＂

Pay through the nose．
－Meaning：pay a great deal for something，sacrifice for
－Example：＂You＇ll pay through the nose to rent a car during the holiday season．＂

## （2）Vocabulary

－Hybrid car（noun）－
－a vehicle that uses two or more distinct power sources to move the vehicle．It uses rechargeable energy storage system，Gasoline／diesel，hydrogen，compressed air，human powered（ex．pedaling，rowing）or wind．
－Example：I can get the best gas mileage with my new hybrid car．
－Compact car（noun）－
－Compact car is a classification of cars which are larger than a super mini and smaller than a large family car．

- Example: I often see compact cars driven by women nowadays.
- Hit the road (idioms)-
- To start a journey; To leave; go away.
- Example: It's getting late - I'd better hit the road.
