To learn a new language, you need to spend a considerable amount of time speaking it, ideally on a day-to-day basis in order to become fluent in it.

Now, let's say you live in the Philippines, in a place with a sizable English community, and you're learning English. If you can practice with a number of individuals every day, I don't see why you would have to go to an English-speaking country.

In my case, I ended up becoming fluent in English only when I was in college because all my subjects are written and spoken in English, forcing me to speak English almost exclusively for many hours every day.
