The **future progressive tense** is not as common as other tenses, and it can some-times be replaced by *simple future*, *present progressive* or even *simple present*.

I'll be leaving in a few minutes.

I'll leave in a few minutes.

I'm going to leave in a few minutes.

I'm leaving in a few minutes.

I leave in a few minutes.
