

1. **Capital city** /'kæp·ɪ·təl/
(noun) a city which is the center of government for a country or other political area
Ex.: I like Seoul, the capital city of South Korea.
2. **Flourishing** /'flɜː·ɪ·fɪŋ/
(adjective) growing or developing successfully
Ex.: Japan is a flourishing city.
3. **Coastal** /'kou·stəl/
(adjective) near the coast
Ex.: They are living in a coastal city.

4. Inland /'ɪn.lænd/

(adjective) away from the sea

5. Remote (city) /rɪ'moʊt/

(adjective) far away in distance and time

(noun) a large city, esp. the main city of a country or region

Ex.: Chicago is a major metropolis.


