GRAMMAR FOCUS

Gerunds and infinitives can both be used as subjects, subject complements, and direct objects of verbs. The choice between which to use as a direct object is sometimes **dictated by the verb**. But the choice of whether to use a gerund or infinitive as a subject, subject

complement, or object of other verbs is left to the speaker/writer. This choice can indicate shades of meaning.

single/repeated	ongoing
request/instruction/causation	attitude (no plan)
(often reduced from modals/ subjunctive/imperative)
