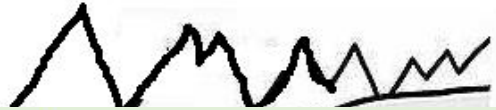


# Phrasal Verb 101 : Lesson 12 "F"

| Verb                     | Meaning                                | Example   |
|--------------------------|--|---|
| <b>fill something in</b> | to write information in blanks (Br.E.) | Please <b>fill in</b> the form with your name, address, and phone number. |

|                           |  |  |
|---------------------------|--|--|
| <b>fill something out</b> | to write information in blanks (N.Amer.) | The form must be <b>filled out</b> in capital letters.                                     |
| <b>fill something up</b>  | fill to the top                          | I always <b>fill</b> the water jug <b>up</b> when it is empty.                             |
| <b>find out</b>           | discover                                 | We don't know where he lives. How can we <b>find out</b> ?                                 |
| <b>find something out</b> | discover                                 | We tried to keep the time of the party a secret, but Samantha <b>found</b> it <b>out</b> . |
