

Verb	Meaning	Example
put something out	extinguish	The neighbours <b>put</b> the fire <b>out</b> before the firemen arrived.
put something together	assemble	I have to <b>put</b> the crib <b>together</b> before the baby arrives.

<b>put up with</b> someone/something	tolerate	I don't think I can <b>put up with</b> three small children in the car.
put something on	put clothing/accessories on your body	Don't forget to <b>put on</b> your new earrings for the party.
