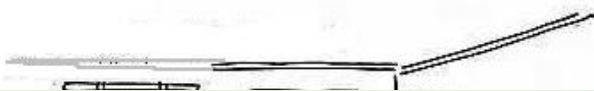


# Phrasal Verb 101: Lesson 29 S

Verb	Meaning	Example
<b>sort</b> <i>something</i> <b>out</b>	organize, resolve a problem	We need to <b>sort</b> the bills <b>out</b> before the first of the month.
<b>stick to</b> <i>something</i>	continue doing something, limit yourself to one particular thing	You will lose weight if you <b>stick to</b> the diet.
<b>switch</b> <i>something</i> <b>off</b>	stop the energy flow, turn off	The light's too bright. Could you <b>switch</b> it <b>off</b> .

<b>switch</b> <i>something</i> <b>on</b>	start the energy flow, turn on	We heard the news as soon as we <b>switched on</b> the car radio.
